GUIDELINES

Background

When Ashburton Jaycees wound up they established a Special Named Fund with Advance Ashburton Community Foundation, to be used for education and development of young people up to the age of forty.

This year income from the fund will be used to sponsor places on the eight day Discovery Course at Outward Bound, Anakiwa in the Marlborough Sounds.

This is a wonderful opportunity for individuals wishing to reach their full potential through challenge and adventure in the outdoors.

Eligibility

Applicants (male or female) shall be between the ages of 27 to 40 and must reside in Mid-Canterbury at the time of application.

Application Closing dates

Applications are considered once a year. For closing dates visit www.advanceashburton.co.nz

Value and Payment of Scholarship

- Full course costs shall be paid by the fund directly to Outward Bound on behalf of the applicant.
- Train fares from Christchurch to Picton and return shall be reimbursed to the successful applicant on production of a travel claim after attending the Course but it shall be the applicant's responsibility and cost to travel to and from Christchurch.

Other Information

- An interview will be required before final selection.
- A scholarship may be revoked if a recipient's behaviour is inappropriate or the recipient has breached the conditions of the Scholarship.
- It is expected that the Outward Bound course will commence within 12 months of final selection.
- Recipients shall be responsible for providing all gear required for the course although Outward Bound have some available.
- Recipients shall be responsible for completing the Outward Bound Application Form and Medical Questionnaire at least 2 weeks prior to the closing date for the Course.
- Recipients shall complete a written report to Advance Ashburton Community Foundation within 3 months of completing the course outlining the benefits gained from attending the course.
- Recipients may be asked by Advance Ashburton to participate in promotional activities as agreed by both parties.

What we are about

Advance Ashburton Community Foundation has been formed as a perpetual charitable trust dedicated to benefiting the Ashburton district. It is registered as a charity under the Charities Act with number of CC28482.

Donated funds are invested and the Foundation distributes the income to worthwhile community organisations and causes, after allowing for inflation. It takes time for funds to grow, but the long term benefits to the Ashburton district will be substantial.
